Response and Recovery Teams Encouraged to Attend the 4th Biennial 2017 Strike Challenge at Camp Rilea this August

August 15-17 RP Advanced Mobile Systems (RPAMS) will host the 4th Biennial Strike Challenge – a domestic capabilities and specialized response equipment demonstration. This unique event offers U.S. response and recovery teams and individuals the opportunity to participate in demonstrations of the newest equipment in emergency response, survivability, security, search and rescue and ‘special’ operations.

Over the course of three days, attendees will get to review the latest equipment – all from U.S. suppliers – designed for response and recovery during chemical, biological, nuclear, radiological, manmade and natural disaster events.
